

"Greetings to the images of Indira Gandhiji and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel on behalf of Rashtriya Seva Yojana"

Jaysinghpur College, Jaysinghpur and Rashtriya Seva Yojana celebrated the death anniversary of Indira Gandhi Gandhi, the first woman Prime Minister of India, and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel, the hero of the struggle for national unity. Indira Gandhi and Sardar Vallabhbhai Patel were greeted with a wreath-laying ceremony. Dr. Tushar Ghatge performed Welcome and introductory speech of this program.

On this occasion, the principal of the college, Dr. Rajendra Kumbhar proposed, while formulating some political and economic developments Indiraji Gandhi deliberately nationalized 14 banks on 19 July 1969 and 8 banks in 1980 in order to oppose the capitalists and to benefit the banking system.

He lauded Patel's work, saying that his contribution to the freedom struggle and social reform movement was indeed a testament to the country's glorious history.





Further he said that the task of challenging divisions such as caste, religion, creed and region can only be done by Gandhi's inspiration and holistic work. After this, the third edition of the book 'Dhairyashil Yodha' was published by the dignitaries.

The chief guest of this gathering and Gandhian thinker Hon. Sanket Munot interacted with the students first with the slogan *Ek rupayaa chandicha, sara desh Ganhicha*. He interacted freely with the students. He said initially he was against Mahatma Gandhi, and adored Nathuram Godse Savarkar, whe were the initial attraction for him. However, when he see Mahatma Gandhi's appearance in the works of the great thinkers and eminent personalities of the country, the curiosity about Gandhi arose his mind. He said that Gandhi Jayanti is celebrated in more than 600 universities internationally and an average of 60 booklets are written every year on Gandhi and more than 2 lakh books have been written on Napoleon and Mahatma Gandhi. Gandhi was the person who lived a simple life having high thoughts. The British imperialism in a number of countries were began to diminish because of spread of Gandhian thoughts.

Furthar he said that in the system created by Hindu fundamentalists in India and Muslim fundamentalists in Pakistan, Mahatma Gandhi's thought became an obstacle. This led to hatred and deadly attacks on him. He expressed the view that to make our country powerful we need to follow the thoughts of Gandhi. The highlight of the event was that Mr. Sanket Munot, a very young and Gandhian thinker, conducted a successful interacting with students through

Mahatma Gandhi's thought, which he succeeded in doing. The students asked a number of questions related to Mahatma Gandhi and satisfactory answers were given by Mr. Munot.
