Under the leadership of Jaysingpur Police Station, the 'Har Ghar Tiranga' initiative was carried out enthusiastically through colleges and schools




Har Ghar Tricolor Awareness Rally, Jaysingpur

The said lecture was given by Prof. Chandrakant Raghunath Khandagale (Retired, Head, Department of Sociology and Logic (Graduate & Post Graduate), Smt. Kasturbai Walchand College, Sangli) was present as the keynote speaker. At the beginning of the program, the chief guests and lecturers were welcomed and introduced by Prof. Dr. K. D. Khaldkar, Head of Department of Political Science. While the introduction of the chief guest Prof. Mrs. Done by Vidya Patil (Assistant Professor, Department of Political Science). Prof. Khandagale in his lecture explains about what is the rights of an individual? What are human rights? What is fundamental right? These concepts are analyzed with examples.
