9. नियोजन म्हणजे काय ? नियोजन प्रक्रियेतील विविध टप्पे स्पष्ट करा.

• नियोजनाचा अर्थ व व्याख्या :

नियोजन ही बौद्धिक प्रक्रिया असली तरी त्याची सोपी, सुलभ व्याख्या देणे शक्य आहे. व्यवस्थापन क्षेत्रातील विविध तज्ज्ञ व मान्यवर लेखांकनी नियोजनाच्या वेगवेगळ्या व्याख्या दिलेल्या आहेत. नियोजनाचा नेमका अर्थ समजण्यासाठी पुढील व्याख्या उपयोगी ठरतील.

व्याख्या :

ऑलन यांच्या मते, "व्यवस्थापन नियोजनात पूर्वानुमान, उद्दिष्टे, धोरण, कार्यक्रम, कार्यपद्धती, वेळापत्रक आणि अंदाजपत्रक तयार करणे यांचा समावेश होतो."

• नियोजन प्रक्रियेतील टप्पे :-

① उद्दिष्ट ठरवणे :

नियोजन प्रक्रियेतील पहिली व अत्यंत महत्वाची बाब म्हणजे उद्दिष्ट निश्चित करणे होय. उद्दिष्ट ठरल्यामुळे काय करावयाचे आहे हे कळते. उद्दिष्ट च जर स्पष्ट नसेल तर योजना तयार करता येणार नाही. नियोजनाचा उद्देश व्यवसाय संस्थेची उद्दिष्टे साध्य करण्यास मदत करणे हा असतो. आर्थिक उद्दिष्टे, सामाजिक उद्दिष्टे, सामान्य उद्दिष्टे व विशेष उद्दिष्टे हा उद्दिष्टांचे प्रकार आहे.

② पूर्वानुमान :

भविष्याचा अचूक अंदाज करणे म्हणजे पूर्वानुमान नियोजनाचा संबंध भविष्यकाळशी येत असल्याने भविष्यात काय परिस्थिती असू शकेल याविषयी योग्य अंदाज केल्या शिवाय योजना तयार करता येणार नाही, व्यवसायात नेहमी चढउतार असतात. तेजी-मंदी येत असते. त्याचा परिणाम योजनेवर होत असतो.

1) व्यवस्थापन संज्ञेची व्याख्या सांगून व्यवस्थापन अभ्यासाची आवश्यकता स्पष्ट करा?

→ अर्थ :-

कोणत्याही कार्याचा विशिष्ट हेतू असतो. हा हेतू साध्य करण्यासाठी आपल्याजवळील उपलब्ध साधनसामग्रीचा जास्तीतजास्त व चांगल्यारितेने उपयोग करण्याचा प्रयत्न केला जातो. तसेच ते विशिष्ट कार्य विचारपूर्वक, नीट व योग्य रितीने पूर्ण करण्याचाही जागीव पूर्वक प्रयत्न करण्यात येतो. मग ते कार्य नोकरीसाठी बी.कॉम. ची पदवी मिळविण्याचे आर्थिक स्वरूपाचे असो वा अन्य कोणत्याही स्वरूपाचे असो. सामाजिक, राजकीय, सांस्कृतिक, धार्मिक व फ्रिडा स्वरूपाचे कार्य असले तरी त्याचेही हेतू साध्य करण्यासाठी साधनसामग्रीची जुळवाजुळव करून त्यांचा पद्धतबिीर उपयोग करण्यावर लक्ष केंद्रित करावे लागते. दुसऱ्या भाषेत कार्याचा हेतू, ज्याला शास्त्रीय भाषेत उद्दिष्ट (objective) म्हणतात, साध्य करणे महत्त्वाचे मानले जाते. कारण हेतू साध्य करणे म्हणजे यशस्वी होणे होय. आपल्या कार्यमध्ये यश मिळविण्यासाठी प्रयत्न करण्याच्या प्रक्रियेमध्ये व्यवस्थापनाची संकल्पना अभिप्रेत आहे.

व्याख्या :-

वरील स्पष्टीकरणावरून 'व्यवस्थापन' या संज्ञेची संकल्पना व स्वरूप स्पष्ट झाले असावे. त्या दृष्टीने वेगवेगळ्या विचारवंतांनी व लेखकांनी 'व्यवस्थापन' संज्ञेची व्याख्या केली आहे. 'व्यवस्थापन' संज्ञेच्या काही व्याख्या पुढीलप्रमाणे आहेत.

1) जेम्स लुन्डी :-

'विशिष्ट उद्देशांच्या प्राप्तीसाठी इतरांच्या प्रयत्नांना नियोजित, समन्वित, प्रेरित व नियंत्रित करण्याचे कार्य म्हणजे व्यवस्थापन होय.

2) जॉर्ज टेशी :-

मानवी साधने व अन्य साधनांचा उपयोग करून उदिते ठरविणारी व साध्य करणारी वैज्ञानिकपूर्ण प्रक्रिया म्हणजे व्यवस्थापन होय.

**व्यवस्थापनाच्या अभ्यासाची आवश्यकता :-**

'व्यवस्थापन' हे एक प्रगत शास्त्र म्हणून विकसित झाले असून त्यास सर्वत्र मान्यता मिळाली आहे. व्यवस्थापनाची तत्वे, तंत्रे व सिद्धांत मानवाच्या आर्थिक, सामाजिक, राजकीय, सांस्कृतिक, धार्मिक तंत्रज्ञान व विज्ञान अशा विविध क्षेत्रांमध्ये उपयुक्त समजली जातात व म्हणून त्यांचा त्या सर्व क्षेत्रांमध्ये कल्पकतेने उपयोग केला जातो. व्यवसाय संस्था (उद्योग व व्यापारी संस्था) तर व्यवस्थापनशास्त्राचा अवलंब करतात. राजकीय क्षेत्रांमध्ये तर काही राजकीय पक्षांनी लोकसभेच्या व विधानसभेच्या निवडणुकांसाठी व्यवस्थापन तंत्रांचा पद्धतशीरपणे उपयोग केलेला दिसून येतो. विद्यार्थ्यांनिश्चूद्धा परीक्षेसाठी अभ्यासक्रमासाठी व यज्ञ मिळवण्यासाठी व्यवस्थापनाच्या तंत्रांचा अवलंब केल्यास त्यांना अपेक्षित यज्ञ निश्चितपणे मिळेल. त्या दृष्टीने व्यवस्थापनाच्या अभ्यासाचे महत्त्व स्पष्ट होते.

आधुनिक वाणिज्य - उद्योगांमध्ये व्यवस्थापनाचे महत्त्व सतत वाढत आहे. आज जागतिकीकरणारे युग आहे. भारतानामुद्धा आपली अर्थव्यवस्था खुली करून आर्थिक नियमन व नियंत्रण त्रिथिल केले आहे. जागतिकपातळीवर सुद्धा व्यापार - उद्योगांच्या दृष्टीने - शब्द राष्ट्रांच्या भौगोलिक सिमा नाममात्र बनल्या आहेत, संपूर्ण जग हे एक लहानसे खेडेगाव (Global village) आहे. अशी संकल्पना सर्व देशांमध्ये रजवली जात आहे. या सर्व पार्श्वभूमिवर देशा-देशांमधील व्यापार उद्योग करणाऱ्या कंपन्यांची कसोटी लागत आहे. उत्पादनाचा खर्च, बाजारपेठीय खर्च, वस्तूंची किंमत, वस्तूंची गुणवत्ता, साधनांची उपलब्धता इत्यादीबाबत स्पर्धेची तीव्रता वाढली आहे. विज्ञान व तंत्रज्ञानाच्या प्रगतीमुळे काही नवे प्रश्न व्यवसायक्षेत्रांमध्ये निर्माण झाले आहेत अशा जागतिक परिस्थितीमध्ये व्यापार - उद्योग करणाऱ्या व्यवसाय संस्थांना आपल्या अस्तित्वासाठी व भविष्यवासाठी अडाडेवे लागत आहे. या सर्व परिस्थितीमुळे व्यवस्थापनाला

iii) सर्वसाधारण नियंत्रण :-

व्यवसायाच्या व व्यवस्थापनाच्या विभिन्न क्रियांवर सर्वसाधारण नियंत्रण ठेवणे हे उच्च व्यवस्थापनाचे सर्वात महत्वाचे कार्य आहे. व्यवसायाच्या उत्पादन, विपणन, वित्त व कर्मचारी या मुख्य चार क्रिया आहेत तर व्यवस्थापनाच्या नियोजन, संघटना, निर्देशन, समन्वय व नियंत्रण या पाच मुख्य क्रिया आहेत. तेव्हा या सर्व क्रियांवर सर्वसाधारण नियंत्रण ठेवणे फार महत्वाचे आहे. व्यवसायाचे आर्थिक यज्ञ, व्यवसायाचे भवितव्य व विकास दृष्टीने सर्वसाधारण नियंत्रण फार महत्वाचे आहे.

\* Role of SEBI in Indian Capital Market

SEBI stands for Securities and Exchange Board of India. SEBI was first established in 1988. The SEBI is playing very significant role in financial system of India. Hence its role in regulating capital markets may be explained as follows:-

1. **Regulating the primary market** - In old days, the organisation of the primary market was very raw and especially unstructured. The primary market is the back-bone of the Indian securities market. Now the operations of primary market are more fair and transparent. The SEBI strictly monitors and supervises all the operations of primary market.
2. **Regulating stock exchanges** - The stock exchanges being secondary capital market is equally important in the financial system of country, as it undertakes trading of the securities. The stock exchanges operate trading daily and lakhs of shares exchange their hands daily. It leads to safe, and transparent working of the stock exchanges.
3. **Regulating the intermediaries** - The SEBI has made registration of all intermediaries operating in the primary market and secondary market compulsory. The working and operations of these intermediaries is strictly monitored by SEBI through norms, rules and regulations. It keeps continuous vigilance on the working of the intermediaries.



13. Taking the Capital market global - Indian capital market is one of the best capital market of the world. The transparent, competitive and safe capital market of India also instrumental for attracting foreign investors. It is because of the SEBI, Indian capital market has become global.



a) Define the term budget. Explain advantages and limitations of Budgetary Control System.

### Meaning of Budget -

Budgeting is a systematic approach to attain the effective management performance. It is an integral part of the management. The budget regulates flow of fund. It involves preparation of a plan relating to the future activities. The term Budget can be defined in a more specific way as under :

"A budget is a comprehensive and co-ordinated plan, expressed in financial term, for the operations and resources of an enterprise for some specific period in the future."

Thus, the term budget refers to -

- a) integrated plan that reduces uncertainty.
- b) expression of activities in financial terms.
- c) planning of an organisation's operations and resources and
- d) future plan of action of an organisation for a specific period of time.

3) Coordination -

Management Control System facilitates coordination among the members of the organization.

Control helps in coordination of activities through unity of action. Every manager will try to coordinate the activities of his subordinates in order to achieve departmental goals. Similarly the chief executive also coordinates the functioning of various departments.

4) Delegation and Decentralization of Authority -

Management control system leads to delegation and decentralization of authority at different operational levels. It facilitates a decision about follow-up action. Control makes delegation easier/better. Decentralization of authority is necessary in big enterprises. The management cannot delegate authority unless and until ensuring proper control. Various control techniques like budgeting, cost control, pre action approvals etc. allow decentralization without losing control over activities.

5) Policy making

Management Control system spurs top management to concentrate on policy making. For control processes management's attention is not required every now and then. The management by exception enables top management to concentrate on policy formulation.





## Paper XIII

- Q1 Write a note on protein biosynthesis in eukaryotes
- - Protein biosynthesis (or protein synthesis) is a core biological process, occurring inside cell, balancing the loss of cellular proteins (via degradation or export) through the production of new protein.
- Protein perform a number of critical functions as enzymes, structural protein or hormones.
  - Protein synthesis is a very similar process for both prokaryotes and eukaryotes but there are some distinct difference.
  - Protein synthesis can be divided broadly into two phases: transcription and translation.
  - During transcription, a section of DNA encoding a protein known as a gene, is converted into a template molecule called messenger RNA (mRNA).
  - This conversion is carried out by enzyme, known as RNA polymerase, in the nucleus of the cell.
  - In eukaryotes this mRNA is initially produced in a premature form (pre-mRNA) which undergoes post-transcriptional modification to produce mature mRNA. The mature mRNA is exported from the cell nucleus via nuclear pores to the cytoplasm for the cell for translation to occur. During translation, the mRNA is read by ribosomes which use the nucleotide sequence to the mRNA to determine the sequence of amino acid. The ribosomes catalyze the formation of covalent peptide bonds between the encoded amino acid to form a polypeptide chain.



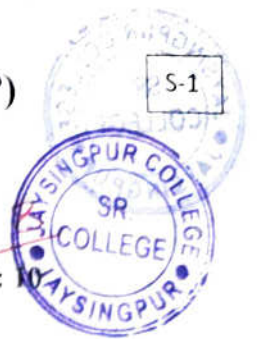
